## DIRECTOR OF LOCAL SERVICES

With a population of approximately 540 people, Délıne, NT is a fly-in community located on the shores of Great Bear Lake in the Sahtú Region. The Délıne Got'ıne Government (DGG) is seeking a qualified, enthusiastic, reliable and responsible Director of Local Services.

### **The Responsibilities:**

Working in a dynamic cross-cultural environment and reporting to the Chief Executive Officer, the Director of Local Services is responsible for the delivery of high-quality public works and community services including, utilities, facilities, water treatment, water delivery, sanitary/waste, garbage removal, equipment maintenance and the airports at the standards established by the DGG. The Director is required to develop project plans, oversee and manage projects, purchase supplies, allocate resources, estimate and monitor job costs and budgets, assist team members in resolving work issues, and liaise with other DGG departments, as well as contractors and service companies in the delivery of projects and services. Considerable independent judgement and action are exercised in performing the work. Complex problems and policy matters are resolved in conjunction with the Chief Executive Officer.

### **The Ideal Candidate:**

- considerable knowledge of municipal infrastructure, including recreation facilities, and the operation and maintenance of water, road, drainage, and other facilities
- knowledge of the principles of water chemistry and water quality, biology and physics as they relate to water distribution and health standards
- five years' experience developing and managing budgets, including project costing and understanding of generally accepted accounting principles
- effective interpersonal and strong written and verbal communications skills
- proven supervisory and team leadership skills, generally gained from two to five years in a leadership role
- experience with Microsoft software (i.e. Excel, Word, and Outlook), and knowledge of databases
- a valid Class 5 driver's licence
- ability to speak North Slavey is an asset

Preference will be given to Délıne Beneficiaries.

The required qualifications would normally be gained through a diploma in Civil Engineering Technology, or other engineering discipline and eight years of related job experience. Training or experience in water treatment is an asset.
